If your proposed change of use is from a Sui Generis use (e.g. a betting office; or pay day loan shop) then there are now specific permitted development rights to cover changes of use to Use Class E (e.g. indoor sport, recreation, or fitness) that do not require a prior approval application.

If your proposed change of use is to a Sui Generis use previously classified as 'assembly and leisure' (e.g. cinemas; concert halls; bingo halls; or dance halls) then this is no longer considered to be permitted development. Proposals remained eligible if applications of this type were submitted before the end of July 2022, but after that point an application for 'Full planning permission' will be required.
